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SPORTS LEADERS

Sports Leaders are expected to do the following at all times to ensure ALL visitors enjoy the event experience:

Behaviour

- > To act as a positive role model at all times.
- Show respect for others.
- Show respect for property.
- > Act with Safety in mind at all times.
- Must arrive for events/sessions on time.
- Work to the best of their ability.
- > Be cooperative and considerate including listening and remaining quiet when instructed.
- Work together.
- Conducting themselves in an appropriate manner- no lying down/leaning on others or property. No eating/chewing gum and using mobile phones without the permission of a member of staff.
- Use appropriate language at all times- No SWEARING
- ➤ Leaders should never show intimidating behaviour Physically, verbally or otherwise.
- Provide all paperwork for staff during the allotted timeframe.

Appearance

Sports leaders are expected to look presentable at all times, this includes:

- Long hair being tied back.
- ➤ All Jewellery to be removed.
- Appropriate clothing (depending on environment/weather).
- Suitable footwear.
- Show positive body language and enthusiasm.
- Act professional in the presence of those whom they are leading.
